Membership

Membership of the Irish Legion Association is open to all ex –members of the PDF and RDF .

Membership will be instated by Membership Application Form only .

Membership is non-gender

Cost of membership is €10.00 per year

Qualification for Membership

Applicants must be :

- Applicants must have served at least one (1) Year service with PDF or RDF and have at least a “Good Conduct” rating on discharge
- Applicants must have at least (1) year of State Service with at least a “Good Conduct” rating
- Must agree to be bound by the Irish Legion Association Constitution Rules and Standing Orders as ratified at the Annual Convention
- Should partake in Irish Legion Association activities (Fundraising, Social and Cultural events, Church & Civil Parades) where applicable.
- Applicants, when accepted to the Irish Legion as a member ,may only retain Membership of one (1) Division of the Irish Legion Association

A Member may transfer to another Division of the Irish Legion Association by completing a Transfer Application Form.

Membership of other Ex-Service Organisations or Associations does NOT disqualify persons from becoming or retaining membership of the Irish Legion Association.

Dress Code

The Irish Legion’s Official Dress is as follows:

- Wine coloured Blazer with The Irish Legion Crest on the left breast pocket
- White Shirt
- Wine coloured tie with red and white stripe under gold sunburst with green harp centred
- Black slacks
- Black shoes
- Grey Beret with Irish Legion cap badge

Note:

The member is required to purchase the above items The dress mentioned above is optional ware but The Irish Legion insists on a neat standard of dress from all members when representing The Irish Legion Association.

Military Decorations

The Irish Legion recognizes all Medals and Ribbons awarded to members during Service to the State and on Peacekeeping Missions with the United Nations and other recognised Peacekeeping Missions.

The Irish Legion also recognises Medals and Ribbons awarded with other Service and Ex-Service Associations within The State of Ireland.

These Awards will be worn on the left side of the Blazer Jacket.

Inherited Awards will be worn on the right side of the Blazer Jacket.
